College Transfer Courses at Partnering Community Colleges

College transfer courses for paraprofessionals as well as courses for lateral entry teachers are offered at reduced tuition (\$60 per course) at partnering community colleges. Textbooks for community college courses are included. Forms are available at www.ncmtec.org.

Consortium Sponsored Courses at Partnering Universities

Undergraduate level teacher education courses are offered at \$80 per course. Graduate level teacher education courses needed to clear a teaching license are offered at \$200 per course. Existing NCMTEC graduate degree cohorts will be limited to one sponsored course per semester.

Tuition Reimbursement

Clients who are clearing a lateral entry license or provisional license may request reimbursement for four courses per year. Requests may be made for reimbursement of up to \$350 per course for courses that are not Consortium sponsored at reduced tuition. Submission of the on-line Tuition Reimbursement Pre-Approval, located on our website, is required by September 15, 2008. Priority will be given to courses sponsored by our partnering colleges and universities and accredited North Carolina Teacher Education programs. Please note that tuition reimbursement is contingent upon the availability of funding; therefore, actual reimbursement may be less than, but no more than \$350 per three-hour course.

Student Teaching Services

NCMTEC paraprofessionals may apply for a need-based stipend while student teaching when required to take an unpaid leave of absence from the school system. Required tuition and fees of up to \$600 for each 3 hour course at an NCMTEC partnering university for the student teaching semester will also be paid. (Financial aid in the form of grants or scholarships must be exhausted before NCMTEC funds are used.)
